

## Three-Year-Program

The purpose of the three year-old-program is to provide the children with a positive first learning experience in a school setting.

### Daily Activities

Each day the children have the opportunity to participate in the following:

**Math:** During calendar time we work on number recognition, sorting, matching, one-to-one correspondence, observations, shapes, patterns, etc.

**Reading:** During story time we work to improve listening skills, attention span, time on task, letter recognition, sound recognition, pre-reading skills, comprehension building skills, etc.

**Religion:** Following our religion program, the children learn about God. They are also encouraged to practice Christian behaviors in school.

**Gross Motor:** During our gym time, the children are encouraged to take part in activities that promote good physical movement. They also enjoy playing on the school playground equipment when weather permits.

**Fine Motor:** During project time, the children develop fine motor skills when cutting paper, coloring, writing their names, playing with play dough, and painting.

**Music:** The children attend music class weekly with the Junior Kindergarten class. We also incorporate songs into our day such as the hello: greeting song, singing our praises to the Lord before snack time, etc...

**Technology:** The children are exposed to computers each Tuesday when they go to the green room with Mrs. Woods.

**Family/School Relationships:** Support from home is most important. When the children see that family members are interested in the daily events at school they are more likely to share their experiences.

**Extra Activities:** Over the course of the year we do take field trips into the community, take part in age appropriate school specials and other special events.
